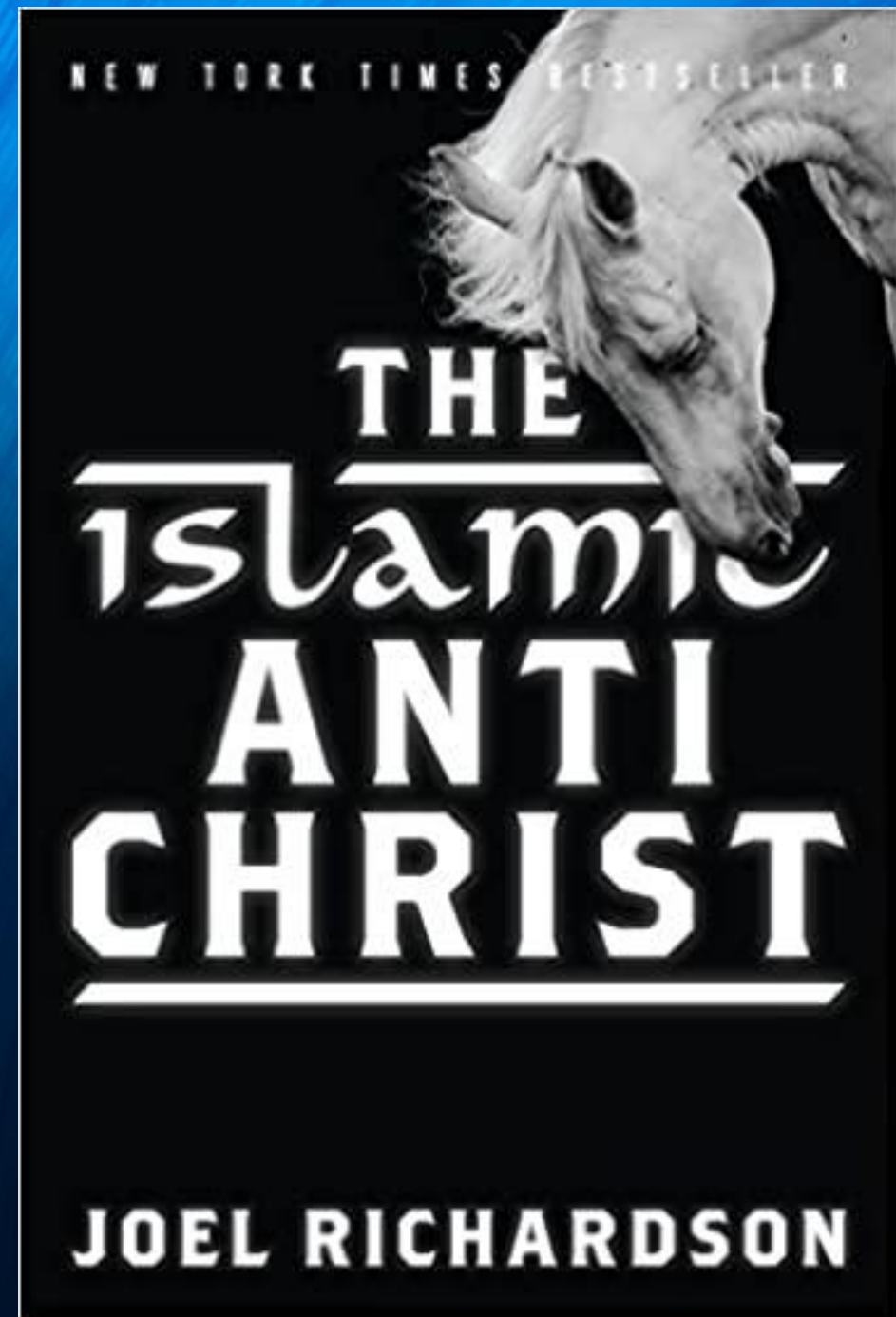

Koran 50:17-21 – We have assigned to every one two scribes (*guardian angels*), the one seated on his right and the other on his left, not a single word does he utter but there is a vigilant guardian ready to note it down. When the agony of death will bring the truth *before his eyes, they will say*: "This is what you were trying to escape!" And the Trumpet shall be blown; that will be the Day of which you were threatened! Each soul will come forth; with it there will be *an angel to drive [to judgment] and an angel to bear witness*.

Based on verse in **Koran - 6: 160**

“He that does a good deed shall be repaid tenfold;
but he that does evil shall be rewarded only with evil.”

Hadith explains: “If someone intends to do a good deed but does not do it, a good deed will be recorded for him. And if he does do it, a reward of ten to seven hundred (**6: 160** only mentions tenfold) or many more times will be recorded for him. And if someone intends to do a bad deed but does not do it, a good deed will be recorded for him. And if he does do it, a bad deed will be recorded against him or God will wipe it out.”

Koran 4: 157-158 – “and for their saying, ‘We killed the Messiah, Jesus the son of Mary, the Messenger (and Prophet) of Allah.’ They did not kill him, nor did they crucify him, but to them, he (the crucified) had been given the look (of Prophet Jesus). Those who differ concerning him (Prophet Jesus) are surely in doubt regarding him, they have no knowledge of him, except the following of supposition, and (it is) a certainty they did not kill him. Rather, Allah raised him up to Him. Allah is Almighty, the Wise.”

Then **fifty prayers** were enjoined on me. I descended till I met Moses who asked me, 'What have you done?' I said, 'fifty prayers have been enjoined on me.' He said, 'I know the people better than you, because I had the hardest experience to bring Bani Israel to obedience. Your followers cannot put up with such obligation. So, return to your Lord and request Him (to reduce the number of prayers.)' I returned and requested Allah (for reduction) and He made it forty. I returned and (met Moses) and had a similar discussion, and then returned again to Allah for reduction and He made it thirty, then twenty, then ten, and then I came to Moses who repeated the same advice. Ultimately Allah reduced it to five. When I came to Moses again, he said, 'What have you done?' I said, 'Allah has made it five only.' He repeated the same advice but I said that I surrendered (to Allah's Final Order)" Allah's Apostle was addressed by Allah, "I have decreed My Obligation and have reduced the burden on My slaves, and I shall reward a single good deed as if it were ten good deeds."
