for ever and ever.**






For God will bring every deed into judgment,



Written in the book of life *from the creation* of the world
Lamb slain *from creation* of the world

He chose us in Him *before the creation* of the world

Ephesians 1: 4-5

Believe, then written?

OR

Written, then believed?



Have mercy on me, O God,
